2026 Learning and Assessment Matters

1. Each year, we share our school's Learning and Assessment Plan (LAP) with all parents/guardians as we believe in partnering you for your child/ward's learning. Our approach towards assessment aims to develop in students the attitudes and habits necessary for them to take greater ownership of their learning.
2. We hope that the assessment plans provided by the school can facilitate your efforts in supporting your child/ward to improve his/her learning effort. The school's assessment policy detailing the use of assessment, expectations of students and promotion criteria is attached for your reference.
3. There are no Mid-year Examinations (MYE) for all levels. Sec 1 to 3 will sit for the End-of-Year Examinations in Term 4, while Sec 4 and 5 take their Preliminary Examinations in Term 3. Refer to Annex A for the FAQ on the removal of MYE for Sec 4 and 5 that started in 2023.
4. Students should not plan to attend any external examinations or events that clash with the school examination dates given in the school calendar. There will be no re-sitting for the papers missed. The school reserves the right to determine whether an absence is valid, and if so, to use its internal benchmarking process to determine the overall performance of the students for the year. 5. We seek your support to encourage your child/ward towards regular attendance and punctuality for school. Do check in regularly on how your child/ward is coping with the assignments given and encourage him/ her to approach their teachers the next day if there are difficulties faced.

Let us work together to apply assessment for continual improvement and focus on our effort to nurture the qualities of self-discipline, perseverance, resilience and time-management in your child/ward.
